

GET THOSE VEGIES IN THE GROUND!

Here's my thoughts on growing great tomato plants.

Dig quite a large hole ready for planting - deeper than you would normally prepare.

At the base of the hole put in a handful of seamungus (or something similar), cover with a small amount of dirt, then put in a banana or a banana skin and again another small handful of dirt.

Then plant the tomato at the top of this mixture and surround it with dirt. The idea of this method is to encourage the tomato to put down deep roots.

Has worked splendidly for me, hope it does for you too.
